# 1. Opening, Welcome

#### 2. Approved of Agenda & Minutes

- 2.1. The agenda was approved.
- 2.2. Minutes of the last meeting were approved by consensus.
  - 2.2.1. Review for any action items.

- 2.2.1.1. Terms of Reference extended the invitation to Amos Key from Brock University - Brian sent the initial invite, and send him the minutes for this entire school's year in preparation of his joining.
- 2.2.1.2. There was a question about point 2.2. about who will be representing Brock University. Sandra stated that she and Amos are in the same department. Tecumseh Centre has appointed Sandra to be the official primary representative but Amos is invited to be a guest/advisor.

  - o Kits are geared to elementary level.
- Post-secondary support program fund is still open funding for Metis students for any student in Ontario - please share with students - also covers graduate education applications are open until July 3, 2020.
- Brian Kon is one of the speakers in the Niagara Falls History Museum Four Direction Speaker Series as part of National Indigenous Month.

## **Brock University**

Aboriginal Student Services – its been a struggle to support students during COVID.

- Lot of communicating with First Nations to find out what barriers students are facing.
- How could we continue to make connections, students said via Instagram and Facebook provided with kits with enough materials for them to make a craft - they have made over 700 kits and are sending them coast to coast.
- Some schools are having students do the research that goes with the craft.
- Will also be making video tutorials to go with the kits.
- Will be offering a virtual Elders program 4 are involved (Nunavut, Nipissing and 2 from Six Nations also looking for a Métis Elder). The program is called **Planting the Seed**, its intended so that student can have the medicines at home to get through the COVID and Elder teachings to go with the medicines. There is a small fee of \$5.00 for non-Brock students to fund the creation of the kits.

#### Niagara Regional Native Centre (NRNC)

- Still providing services virtually and food drop-offs.
- Planned a graduation and sent letter to all of IEAC 30 students have registered June 27 there will be a drive through ceremony at the centre - will get medicines, cake certificate, teachings.
- Are looking to have a virtual summer camp for 6 weeks in July and August should be posted in the next week on their site.

#### Gary (FENFC)

- Making calls to support mental health needs of students:
  - o some of our youth are doing well, but there are a lot of community members who are struggling. We all need to extend a helping hand to those as best we can.

## Niagara College

- Looking for elder support, have a male and female elder who are available 3 hours a
  week for students.
- Have a NPAAMB lounge and NC Indigenous lounge for students to connect.
- Have a quarantine challenge pic of how they are practicing their culture while in quarantine.
- Partnering with sustainability and horticulture doing some strawberry teachings.
- Videos with elders harvesting sweet grass which will be shared with community.
