GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:

Length of Program: 9 days in-school program at DSBN

Group Size: Minimum 15 students (Maximum group size may apply)

Age Limitations: International students must be between 10-13 years of age for an elementary group and 14-17 years of age for a secondary group.

Deadline: Due to limited space, groups are to be accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis. **Requests for a summer program are to be submitted to the DSBN as soon as possible. Summer program agreement with DSBN is to be signed by February 15, 2020.** Deadline for student names later.

Supervision: Students must arrive in and depart from Niagara at the same time and be accompanied while in Niagara by a mature and responsible chaperone. Arrival and departure times should avoid late night and very early morning.

In-School Program: Students attend classes directed by DSBN teachers. Students study alongside their peers with the addition of some DSBN students assisting in the classrooms. An English-only speaking policy is in effect at school to ensure an English-immersion experience.

DSBN SUMMER IN-SCHOOL FEES (9-day in-school program):

APPLICATION FEE: CAD\$150 per student (non-refundable)

TUITION FEES: For a group of 45: CAD\$800 per student
For a group of 30: CAD\$850 per student
For a group of 15: CAD\$900 per student
