GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:

Length of Program: 2-3 weeks (January 13-29, 2021)

Group Size: Minimum 15 students (Maximum group size may apply)

Age Limitations: International students must be between 10-14 years of age.

Deadline: Due to limited space, groups are to be accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis. **Requests for a winter program are to be submitted to the DSBN as soon as possible. Winter program agreement with DSBN must be signed by September 20, 2020.** Deadline for student names later.

Supervision: Students must arrive in and depart from Niagara at the same time and be accompanied while in Niagara by a mature and responsible chaperone. Arrival and departure times should avoid late night and very early morning.

Integration into DSBN Classrooms: Students will integrate into and attend regular classrooms of the DSBN on a daily basis and will participate in all regular school activities alongside English-speaking DSBN students. This integration provides for a strong English-immersion experience.

DSBN WINTER CLASSROOM FEES:

APPLICATION FEE: CAD\$150 per student (non-refundable)

TUITION FEES: CAD\$78 per school day per student

HOMESTAY AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

Homestay Placement: Two students will be placed with a homestay. Students will attend the DSBN school designated in the boundary of the homestay address.

Weekday after-school extra-curricular activities: Sample activities could include: movies, hockey game, brand name outlet shopping, etc.

Full-day excursions: Sample excursions could include: Niagara Falls sight-seeing; Toronto's CN Tower; Castle; Royal Ontario Museum; Ontario Science Centre; Eaton's Shopping Centre; Sports Camp at Brock University; Visit to University of Toronto; 3-day trip to Ottawa and Montreal; etc.

Extra-curricular provisions: All activities, outside the regular school hours, will be organized and supervised by a local, experienced service provider working closely with the DSBN and the client group. **All costs associated with these extra-curricular activities will be quoted by the service provider separate from the in-school tuition fees quoted above by the DSBN.**

HOMESTAY AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR (ONLY) WINTER PROGRAM FEES:

Homestay services and Extra-curricular activities are delivered by a Service Provider based in Niagara with whom the DSBN works closely and regularly.
