

APPLICATION TIPS:

Reminders:

- **Note:** To register, you must **LIVE in Niagara**.
- **Proof of Address:** Please **ONLY** include the portion of the bill that shows your proof of address. Please **HOLD** on **sharing other personal bill information**.
If you do not have a bill with your name on it & if you live with a parent/ guardian/ caregiver, please include a bill with the name of one of the above.
- **New to DSBN (Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents and Non- Canadian Citizens)**
Please review all details in the section titled **New to DSBN**.
Before you apply: Please ensure that you collect the required supporting documents and complete any pre-application steps.

How to submit a complete application?

- Prior to completing the application, download and save it to your computer
- Please send **ONE** email with:
 - a) the saved application and B) all required supporting documents to ace@dsbn.org.
- Please ensure that all documents are clear. If you submit photos of documents, the photo must be taken straight- on, be in focus and have no glare.
- If you have difficulties submitting your registration form or uploading your documents, please contact ace@dsbn.org.

Frequently Asked Questions

Ontario Education Number (OEN)

- You can locate this on your transcript or a report card.

Transcripts:

- Please provide transcripts from **ALL** the schools you have attended
- **YOU** must request copies of your transcript. **We CANNOT** request copies for you
- **Note-** Copies of OUAC or OCAS transcript uploads **are not accepted. Official transcripts are required.**
- Contact **all schools** that you attended to request your transcripts
- Attended a DSBN secondary school more than 5 years ago?

NEW to DSBN:

Documents that will be requested when you complete the application:

A) Canadian Citizen Born in Canada

- Birth Certificate **and** Canadian passport details page

B) Canadian Citizen Born in Another Country

- Birth Certificate, Passport details page and page with date of entry into Canada
- Please see Credential Assessment Evaluation support section below

C) Permanent Residents

- Front and back of permanent resident card AND passport page including date of entry to Canada
- You will need to provide a copy of Level 6 results in all 4 areas (Reading, Writing, Speaking & Listening)
