SCHOOL YEAR CALENDARS 2022-23

BACKGROUND

The Education Act, Regulation 304 — School Year Calendar, Professional Activity Days, sets the requirements for the preparation and submission of school year calendars to the Ministry of Education for approval.

The 2022-2023 calendar provides for 196 possible school days between September 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023. The school year shall include a minimum of 194 school days of which three days shall be designated as professional activity days. In addition, up to four days may be designated by the Board as professional activity days. The remaining school days shall be instructional days. The Board may designate up to ten instructional days as examination days.

SUMMARY

Proposed Modifications to 2022-2023 School Year Calendar:

The Education Act permits a board to designate a school year and school holidays that are different from those prescribed by the Ministry. As such, DSBN is proposing a modified calendar for 2022-23, which includes the following:

• move the two-week Winter Break from Monday, December 19, 2022-Friday, December 30, 2022 to Monday, December 26, 2022-Friday, January 6, 2023.

A 2022-2023 calendar that includes the above changes meets all other school calendar requirements including 194 school days and includes 7 professional activity days between September 1st and June 30th.



SECONDARY TECHNOLOGY & SHSM PROGRAM UPDATE

BACKGROUND

DSBN continues to be a leader in the province offering 72 SHSM programs in 15 different sectors. Last year was challenging for many of our technology programs with students having to pivot to online learning multiple times throughout the year. We adapted many of our certifications and programming to be completed online to comply with COVID protocols.

The Ministry of Education's initial goal was to have 25% of students in Grades 11 & 12 enroll in an SHSM program. However, the Ministry is now focused on further growing enrollment in the skilled trade sectors of SHSM. There are 13 identified sectors with skilled trades. Over the past three years DSBN has had a larger footprint than the province as shown in the graph below.

Completion rates are defined as those students who achieve their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) with their SHSM red seal. In the 2020-21 school year 79% of DSBN'S SHSM students completed their OSSD with the red seal.

NEW SHSM APPLICATIONS

Each year we review our current SHSM programs, enrollment, and completion rates. As student interests change, schools review their current programs and local context to propose new applications. We are submitting 5 new SHSM applications to the Ministry of Education later this month. They are:

- 1. E.L. Crossley Construction
- 2. Welland Centennial Environment
- 3. St. Catharines Collegiate Health & Wellness
- 4. West Niagara Secondary School Manufacturing*
- 5. West Niagara Secondary School Construction*
- * Manufacturing and construction programs have existed for over 14 years at Beamsville and Grimsby; however, we have an opportunity to refresh them with the opening of the new West Niagara SS.

SUMMARY

DSBN continues to engage students in activities to promote technology, SHSM and the skilled trades. We have many upcoming events for students in Grades 7 & 8, specific programs to target underrepresented populations, and of course our Spring Skills Competitions.
