

Purpose & Goals of Program

- ▶ The Ministry of Education provided DSBN with specialized funding to offer :
 - ▶ 8-10 weekly after school sessions
 - ▶ 8 locations in DSBN classrooms, 9 groups running
 - ▶ Ages 5yrs to 9yrs with a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder
 - ▶ ABA based program focusing on the development of daily living skills, social skills and self-regulation skills through fun and engaging group activities at local schools.
- ▶ Serving 90 students
- ▶ Each student has 1-3 individualized goals for self-regulation and social skills
- ▶ Data taken at each session; pre and post data collected

 - ▶ Bethesda staff
 - ▶ Educational Assistants & DECE staff
 - ▶ All staff provide 1:1, small group instruction, rotate through activities from lessons to fun activities involving goals

Lesson plan/visual schedule

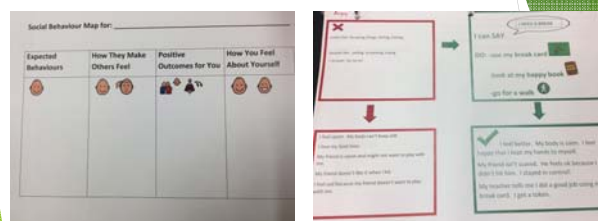
- ▶ Entry and snack

- ▶ ** a program binder was provided to each location, with lesson plans, examples of various tools and templates, goal sheets

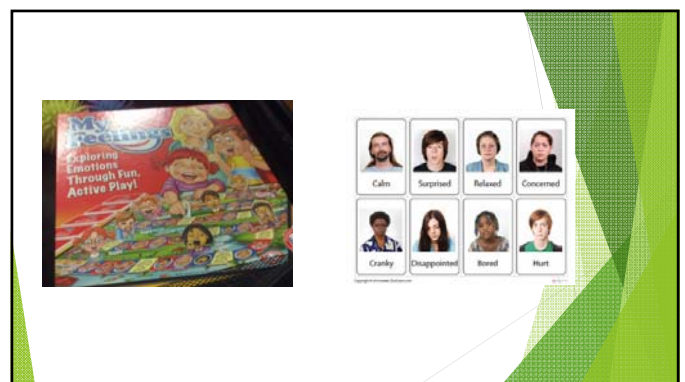
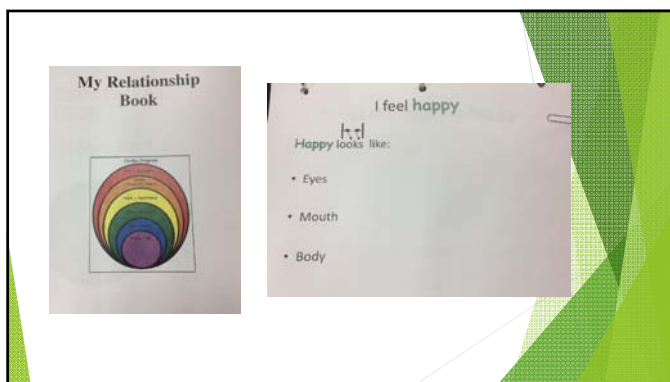
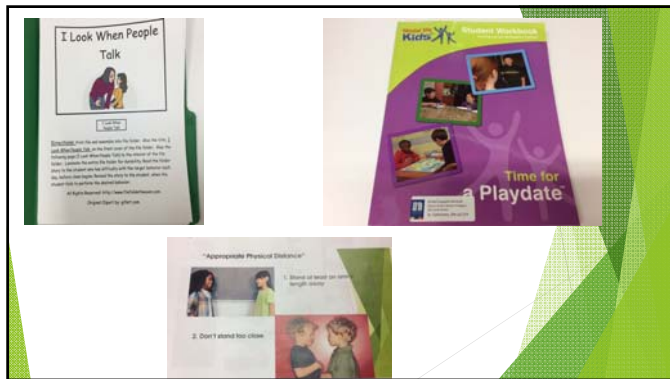
Examples of Student Goals
