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PURPOSE OF THE CONTEST:

ENTRY: Students must register online at <u>2024 Skills Challenge Registration Form</u> with all the required information completed to be eligible to participate.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

- **Photographic Eye -** Focus on composition, cropping, use of visual elements, and general creativity/recognition of overall aesthetics.
- Digital Capture in RAW or JPEG Ability to capture images that are sharp/in-focus
- **Post Production** Editing, colour correction, retouching and manipulation of images.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:

Safety is a priority at the Skills Ontario Competition. Please be sure to review safe practices before students participate in the photoshoot portion of the competition. At the discretion of the judges and technical chairs, any competitor can be removed from the competition for the submission of inappropriate subject matter.

EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, TOOLS, AND SUPPLIES:

Equipment Supplied by the Competitor or School:

- Computers
- Digital Camera (DSLR or Point and Shoot) and SD cards
- Camera Accessories (ie. flash, tripod, batteries, etc.)
- Card Readers if necessary

Equipment Supplied by the Organizer/Committee:

- iMac computers to edit
- Software (Adobe Photoshop)
- Note: NO PHONE APPS are to be used for the editing portion of the competition

Digital Portfolio *(this is completed and submitted before the day of competition)

The Digital Portfolio is to be 10 of your best images in digital format. The photos are to be JPEG files, correctly formatted to a maximum of 2000 pixels wide for on-screen viewing. **These files will not be printed**. This digital portfolio will be shared via Google Drive and presented to the judges. **See further info on the last page.** Please ensure at least 4 of the photos from the digital portfolio are in colour.
