- Ontario or Canadian Teacher's Certificate of Qualification
- Bachelor's degree in Education or English
- Must be a native English speaker

With a vision to educate young students in Korea with Canadian education programs, the Canada School South Korea (CS) at <a href="www.goodcanadaschool.com">www.goodcanadaschool.com</a> was established in July 2009 on Geoje Island (<a href="www.geoje.go.kr">www.geoje.go.kr</a>), one of the most beautiful islands on the Southern coastline of Korea. The CS operates with Canadian-certified teachers and has grown steadily to the current enrolment of 80 students who are of all ages.

The District School Board of Niagara is providing teacher recruitment services to the Canada School. Any teacher recruited by the DSBN and hired by the CS will be an employee solely of the CS and not of the DSBN, and will report to the CEO/Principal of the Canada School in Geoje City, South Korea.

Accordingly, the CS invites qualified and capable teachers to apply for the above positions. These positions are for the contract periods stated above and can be extended at the mutual agreement of the parties. Candidates must have a willingness to adapt to a different cultural context and to work as a team in a challenging teaching environment.

### **Duties Include:**

- working as a member of a school academic team to enable the ongoing success of the school
- encouraging all pupils in the pursuit of learning
- assisting the Principal in the general organization and management of the school
- maintaining appropriate pupil records
- preparing short and long range teaching plans and administering prepared activities to ensure effective teaching and learning strategies
- ensuring that the effective assessment and evaluation strategies are implemented
- participating in activities other than classroom instruction which include school-related sports, arts, and cultural activities enhancing pupils' education
- supporting and working closely with the school Principal in maintaining close cooperation with the community and in promoting the school

#### Other Requirements:

- New or experienced teachers are welcome to apply
- evidence of an ability to work collaboratively with teachers, parents, administrators, and students
- a strong interest in creating a school environment that is inviting, dynamic, and attentive to the educational needs of students
- must be a native English speaker
- acceptable vulnerable-sector police check original dated within 6 mos. of start date

## **Compensation Package:**

- Salary for Ontario (or other Cdn provincial) certified teacher is KRW\$27.3 million South Korean Won (to date approx. CAD\$25,230) including bonus and pension. Korean income tax of 2-3% will be deducted from this salary.
- Return airfare (Toronto Seoul);
- Paid furnished private or shared accommodation;
- Paid public holidays equaling 2 weeks and paid private holidays of 8 days
- Paid healthcare insurance, industrial accident insurance, and pension.

  - iii) the start date of your desired teaching position(s) in order of preference
  - iv) briefly state your teaching experience highlighting both your Ontario (or Canadian) experience and any international or ESL teaching experience
- 4) Include a resume that clearly outlines your qualifications and experience and provide 3 letters of reference (2 from people who have been in a supervisory position to you as an employer or a teacher program advisor AND 1 from a family member).
