# **eLEARNING-NEW CREDIT SUMMER SCHOOL**

Wednesday July 4 to Tuesday July 31, 2018

Students must have a working computer and internet connection available to them daily.

#### **COURSE CANCELLATIONS**

If your choices are not available because of lack of enrolment, you will be notified by phone or email before the course start date. The courses being offered online are listed below and are subject to sufficient enrolment.

#### REGISTRATION

DSBN Guidance: Students must be registered in the OeLC registration site before submitting a registration form. If you have pre-registered for a course through your Guidance Department, you will automatically be put on a class list. You will receive confirmation of enrolment via the email address provided. You may only register in ONE online course.

Student emails should be ACTIVE and checked regularly. Occasionally registration emails will be directed into Junk mail boxes (please check these regularly as well). More details regarding course access will be provided via email once a student has registered.

#### **VISA FEE PAYING STUDENTS**

Students registered in a day school as a VISA student will be required to pay a fee of \$550 to take a summer school credit course. Payment will be required before the start of the program and the fee paid by cash or cheque (made payable to the DSBN) are to be brought to the Adult & Community Education office at 535 Lake St, St. Catharines in the Lifetime Learning Centre, Room 101, Monday to Friday 9:00 am to 3:30 pm

#### LATE REGISTRATION

Completed Summer School registration (signed by your Home School Principal) will be accepted for all new credit eLearning courses if they are entered into the eLearning Registration System by your home school guidance counsellor. Or the student can bring the form in person on one of these dates, Wednesday July 4 - Friday July 6, 2018, 8:00 am – 1:10 pm; to A.N. Meyer Secondary School or Sir. Winston Secondary School ONLY.

#### ATTENDANCE

Course material is covered in a short period in Summer School; therefore, it is very important that online attendance and participation be made a priority. Course material will be delivered in an eLearning (online) format, and it is suggested that all students attend an orientation at one of the Summer Semester locations (see Orientation info below). Students must complete an online orientation module before they begin to work on their course. Students and their families must ensure that summer jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize their enrolment status. Final evaluation will be conducted online as outlined by the course syllabus and must be completed on Tuesday July 31st. Students must be available on these dates as required by the teacher.
